



Freshman Admission Application **Check-List**

- Admission Application** – Applications may be completed and mailed to the office of admissions or sent electronically on the web at www.woodbury.edu. The application fee is \$50.00.
- Transcript(s)** – High School transcript must be submitted sealed (unopened) to the office of admissions or mailed directly from the issuing high school. In addition, please submit any official college transcripts (if applicable).
- Examination(s)** – SAT I score and/or ACT score is required and must be official. Scores need to be mailed directly from the Examination Board(s) to the office of admissions.
- Portfolio** – A collection of your artistic work in any desired format for students applying for any of the design majors. Not required for admission but is necessary for faculty review.
- Personal Statement** – An essay, at least 500 words, in a topic of your choice (see admission application for essay questions). Please note the personal statement is optional but highly recommended.
- Letters of Recommendation** – Three letters of recommendations from teachers, academic counselors, or other academic professional personnel. Please note letters of recommendations are optional but highly recommended.
- Interview** – An interview, in person or by phone, may be requested by an admission counselor.
