<sup>1</sup> Completion of the MBA program requires 36 units unless *additional* requirements are identified at admission. Annual tuition increases will apply to subsequent years.

<sup>2</sup> Master of Architecture programs run 1, 2 or 3 years. Units required for each will vary. MS-Arch is a 1-year program which requires 36 units. The M-Arch 2-year program requires 63 units, and the M-Arch 3-year program requires 93 units. The Master of Real Estate Development program in San Diego requires 39 units.
