Please read carefully.

Pre-requisite

Students seeking initial credit must have a "B" or better in previous related course work. Each ICSS course offers a full year of high school credit (10 credits) within a condensed format – 24 days. One instructional day is equivalent to one week of instruction and curriculum in a regular school year. Rigor and pacing are rapid. Please consider carefully before enrolling students who have struggled in a specific subject area within the regular school year.

Attendance

Students who miss the first day of class are subject to losing their spot and being dropped from the class. Additionally, students who miss more than two instructional days total may be dropped from the class. Daily attendance is expected and absences will affect final grades. If you are absent for any reason, it is the student's responsibility to communicate with his/her teacher and complete assignments in a timely manner.

Grades & Transcripts

<u>BUSD Students</u>: At the end of each semester, you will be given a grade slip. All grades will be recorded and shared with BUSD unless otherwise requested. Please note that Woodbury University does NOT give college credit for this program.

<u>Village Christian Students</u>: At the end of each semester, you will be given a grade slip. Woodbury will mail your grade to Village Christian. Please note that Woodbury University does NOT give college credit for this program.

Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations must be received in writing via email to Kelly Nittoli (summerprograms@woodbury.edu). A full refund will be granted to students who cancel enrollment by 5 PM on Friday, May 19, 2017. Cancellations received after 5 PM on May 19 and before 3 PM on the second day of class (either Tuesday, June 6 or, if enrolled in Semester B only, Tuesday, June 27) will be awarded a 50% refund. Refunds will not be granted after the second day of class. Full refunds will be given to students who enroll in a class that is cancelled due to low enrollment. Classes with fewer than 15 students are subject to cancellation.

Students with Disabilities
