APPLICATION PRIORITY DEADLINE

FALL SEMESTER | MARCH 1

Applications will be accepted after the priority deadline until maximum enrollment is reached.

Fall semester begins in August.

ELIGIBILITY

BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM A REGIONALLY ACCREDITED INSTITUTION.

Prior to application submission, applicants are required to select one of the programs listed below:

- MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE (M.ARCH.)
- MASTER OF INTERIOR DESIGN (M.I.D.)
- MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ARCHITECTURE (M.S.ARCH.)
- MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ARCHITECTURE, REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT (M.S.ARCH.RED)
(San Diego campus ONLY)

DOMESTIC APPLICANTS

- COMPLETE ONLINE APPLICATION
- SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM ALL COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES ATTENDED
- UPLOAD PROFESSIONAL RESUME/CURRICULUM VITAE TO ONLINE APPLICATION
- REQUEST (2) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION THROUGH THE ONLINE APPLICATION (*Academic and/or professional; recommender contact information to be submitted as a part of the online application. Your recommender will receive a link from WU to submit their letter. All recommendations must be sent directly from the recommender to Woodbury.*)
- STATEMENT OF PURPOSE
Submit a one-or-two-page essay via our online application that describes your educational and/or professional background, and your reason for pursuing a graduate architectural education at Woodbury's School of Architecture.

PORTFOLIO

All graduate design applicants are required to submit a portfolio of creative work conveying the scope of their design experience.

INTERVIEW

May be requested by the School of Architecture upon review of complete application.

The following requirements are for Master of Science Architecture applicants only:

RESEARCH STATEMENT

Submit a 1 to 2-page essay outlining your specific area(s) of interest and identifying any faculty members you feel could serve as an advisor for your work.

We can only accommodate students whose research interests match that of a faculty member who is able to serve as an advisor.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

In addition to meeting the above admission requirements, international students must submit the following:

- CERTIFIED AND/OR OFFICIAL COPIES OF ACADEMIC RECORDS with certified English translation and course-by-course evaluation from a NACES approved translation service.
- OFFICIAL TOEFL OR IELTS SCORE REPORT
 - Minimum TOEFL: 80
 - Minimum IELTS: 6.5
 - Minimum Duolingo: 105
- COPY OF PASSPORT
- BANK STATEMENT
Bank Statement issued no earlier than 6 months from enrollment date. Optional at the time of application submission. Financial support must be sufficient to cover student living expenses for one full academic year. Bank statements must be original, and on letterhead from a checking, savings, or time deposit account. Brokerage (stock funds), real estate, or any other non-liquid assets are *not acceptable*. All bank statements must be in English and in U.S. dollar currency or its foreign equivalence. A Sponsor Form is required for any document which is not in the name of the applicant.
