Below are the current (as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023) Woodbury University guidelines regarding COVID-19 and Influenza vaccinations. The following policies and procedures are subject to change based on LA county public health recommendations.

**COVID-19 Vaccination**

All faculty, staff, Students, and visitors will no longer be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination.

**Influenza Vaccination**

All faculty, staff, Students, and visitors will no longer be required to show proof of Influenza vaccination.

**Testing Positive for COVID-19, Isolation Guidelines & Return to campus:**

ALL community members – (This includes all faculty, staff, and students) who experience symptoms of COVID-19 or test positive will still need to complete the linked form <https://forms.office.com/r/CbgpcWP8zP> AND contact the Health Center at [healthcenter@woodbury.edu](mailto:healthcenter@woodbury.edu).

A negative COVID-19 test result is not required in order to return to campus.

**On-Campus COVID-19 Testing:**

Rapid antigen tests are available at the Health Center for those who are experiencing symptoms or in the event of an outbreak.
