### IMMUNIZATION POLICY STATEMENT

**All immunization records must be submitted online through your SNAP Student Health Portal at: <https://www.studentehr.com/>**

You will receive an email from [noreply@studentehr.com](mailto:noreply@studentehr.com) as soon as you are approved for Housing. Please check your Junk folder as well. It will be addressed to the Parent or Guardian of **Your name:**

**This is from the SNAP portal with your username and password. Do not ignore this email.**

**For all housing students, the first deadline to submit your vaccination records will be announced when you are approved for Housing. The final deadline to submit your records will be the day before Move-in date.**

The Health Center can assist you with making the necessary arrangements to fulfill your immunization requirements if needed. If you need immunizations, you will need to email or call the health office (contact info below) to send you a link to the Proof of Intent form. This form creates a plan for vaccination and grants you an exemption based on the date of your appointment for vaccinations.

Immunizations that are **REQUIRED** for all Housing Students:

### **REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS FOR HOUSING STUDENTS**

<b>Vaccination Requirements</b>	<b>Dosage Information</b>
Hepatitis B	3 doses required OR titer result (blood test) showing positive immunity
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses required OR titer results (blood test) showing positive immunity
Meningococcal Conjugate (Menactra)	1 dose given after the age of 16. <i>This requirement is for students 21 years old and younger.</i>

Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, aPertussis)	1 dose every 10 years (booster)
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses required OR titer results (blood test) showing positive immunity
Screening: Tuberculosis testing (TB)	Tb skin test OR blood test (QuantiFERON-TB Gold). Chest X-ray is required if skin test is positive

### **REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

<b>Vaccination Requirements</b>	<b>Dosage Information</b>
Screening: Tuberculosis Testing (TB)	Tb skin test OR blood test (QuantiFERON-TB Gold). Current (within 12 months) chest X-ray is required if skin test shows a positive result.
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses required OR titer results (blood test) showing positive immunity
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses required OR titer results (blood test) showing positive immunity

### **VIOLATIONS OF THIS POLICY**

**After the First deadline and no vaccination plan in place with the Health Center:**

1. Not allowed to live on campus.
  1. Housing contract terminated prepayment refunded.

**Failure to follow through with an approved vaccination plan and after move-in day:**

1. Step 1 - \$50 fine end of the first week.
2. Step 2 -\$100 fine end of second week.
3. Step 3 - Housing contract terminated prepayment refunded.
