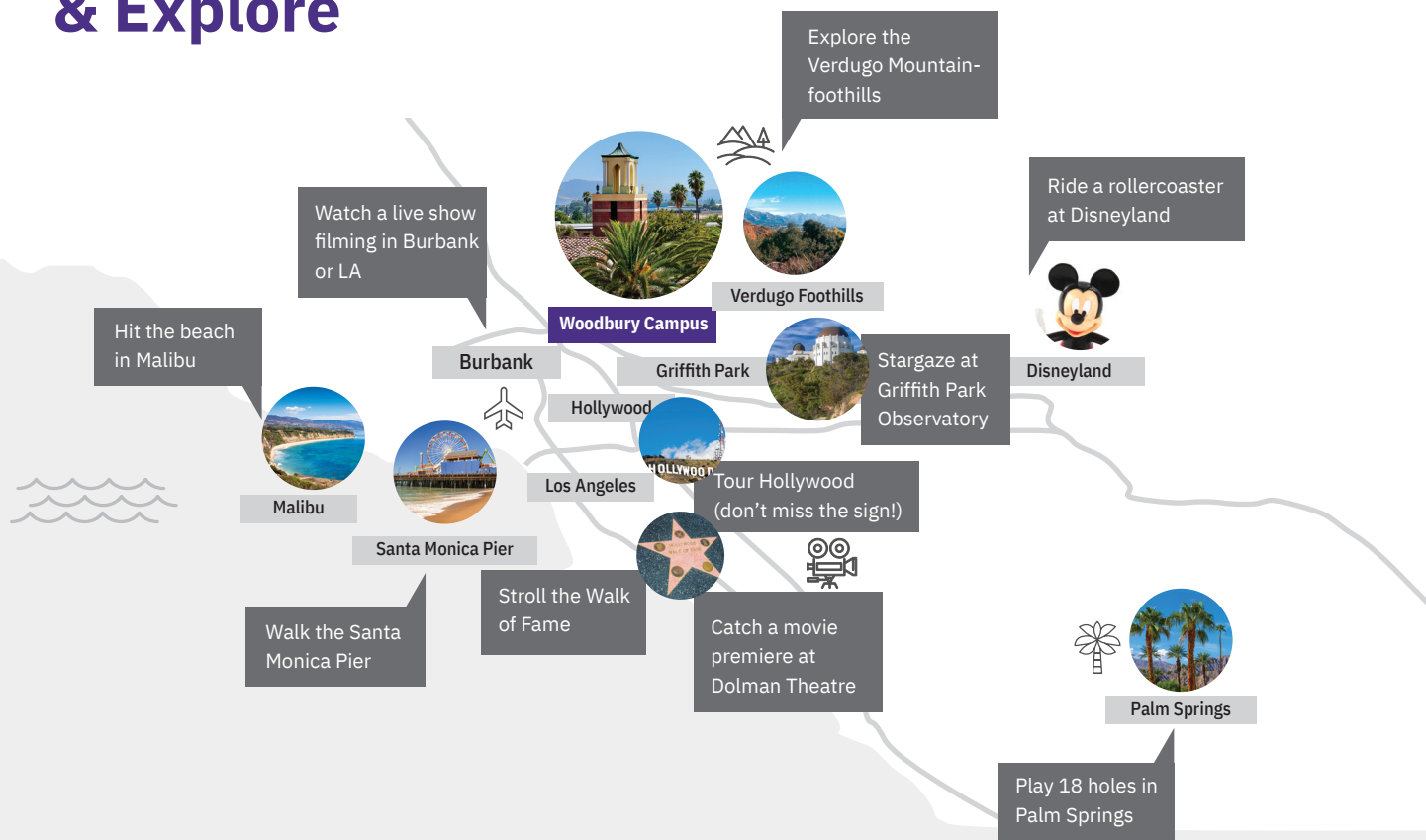

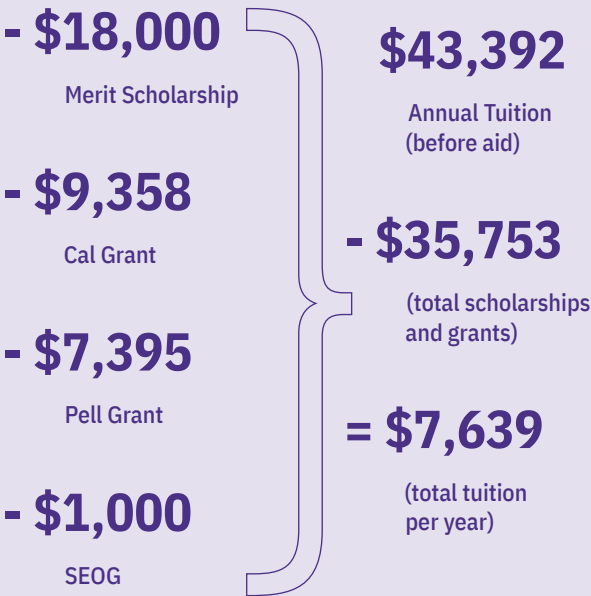

These costs are designed to help families determine how much it will cost to attend Woodbury University. **With a GPA of 3.40–3.69**, the following scholarships and grants significantly reduce annual tuition cost:

Merit Scholarships

Every student that applies to Woodbury is automatically considered for a scholarship for as much as \$20,000!

Awards are based on the following unweighted GPA ranges:

- Presidential Merit Scholarship: \$20,000 [3.70 GPA and above]
- Dean Merit Scholarship \$18,000 [3.40-3.69 GPA]
- Woodbury Educational Grant \$12,000 [2.95-3.39 GPA]
- Woodbury Educational Grant \$8,000 [2.50-2.94 GPA]

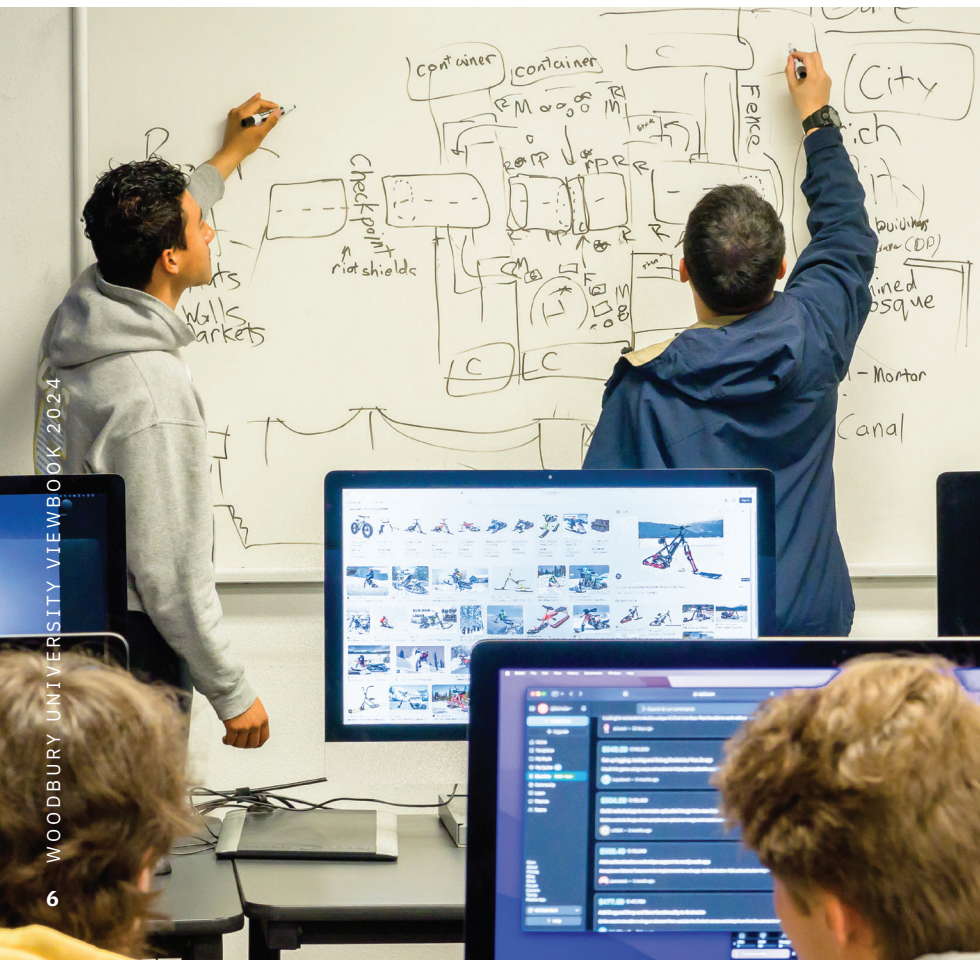
